FIRST GRADE **UNIT I**

WHAT'S THE WEATHER LIKE TODAY?

Central Idea: The measurable changes of the weather impact our lives.

In this unit students inquired into the weather and seasons. They discussed various types of weather and how temperatures and climates differ around the world. Students learned to measure, record, and track temperatures. First grade learned about graphs, interpreting data, and the use of symbols.

Students will be inquiring into the different types of landforms, the world we live in, and cultural values. Students will also learn about patriotism and how it differs in demonstration from country to country.




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
